With the conclusion of that research, a presentation occurred at our October 9 2018 SVANC board meeting. The committee invited CHSRA to present the Support Side, with our SVANC HSR Committee Member Susan Lustig presenting the Non-Support Side. Sun Valley Library will be included as a "recommended" posting location because of its exposure to Sun Valley stakeholders, and arrangements should be made to post all agendas there for informational purposes as soon as access is available and/or library personnel are able to assist us with posting.
