Attached is the agenda for Monday's meeting. There are two applications regarding Cell Towers. Both item 3 and item 4 will come up for a hearing before we have another regular board meeting, so I am calling a joint meeting of the board to be able to take a vote on these two items and get a letter listing our concerns about these installations before the hearing commission.

Attached is the agenda and a picture of a cell tower in Glassell Park which is an obelisk. It makes a nice NEIGHBORHOOD distinguishing marker. This I want you to consider for the cell tower at Lehigh and the 5 fwy. It will be 53 ft 6 in tall. This is right at the Sunland Blvd at the northbound 5 fwy entrance. I think it will be nicer than an ugly monopole disguised as a pine tree. Thank you Julie Monroy who found this installation.

The other cell tower is at Truesdale and Glenoaks. They want a 58 ft tall just plain antenna. I think we should restrict them to 40 ft which is the zoning and make them disguise it as a pine tree and plant four 25 ft Nursery size live pine trees around the phony pine tree.

I want to request that both installations be removed when the technology changes so that as they are able to use smaller discreet antennas we are not looking at these ugly structures forever.
