From CD2 City Councilmember Paul Krekorian's newsletter about this City Council Motion (note, all Councilmembers except Cedillo approved this motion, including Martinez):

*In May, I sent a letter to State Senator Bob Hertzberg urging his opposition to Senate Bills 9 and 10, making the point that both measures represented a gross overreach of state government into areas of land use jurisdiction.*

*Today, the Council approved a motion that I co-sponsored with Councilmember Paul Koretz urging opposition to Senate Bill 9 and Senate Bill 10.*

*In my remarks, I called the bills "trickle- down housing policy," which will not create more affordable housing in Los Angeles, as the proponents claim. Instead of offering ill-conceived bills, the State should use a larger portion of its surplus to boost the City's woefully underfunded Affordable Housing Trust Fund. Regarding the housing crisis, **we don't need mandates from Sacramento, we need solutions.***
